Metuchen Public Library – Junebug Art Gallery: A first for Junebug, the Metuchen Public Library is hosting an exhibit of the works from one dozen local artists and crafters throughout June. Located in the Community Room on the 2nd floor, the Library Gallery features a beautiful collection of paintings, photographs and pottery.

- A Junebug related photo-op can be found at the main entrance to the library (Middlesex Avenue), where visitors can snap a photo and look like a colorful winged creature.
- The Metuchen Public Library is located at 480 Middlesex Avenue, just past Borough Hall.

Junebug Window Galleries Hosted by downtown Metuchen businesses, these window displays showcase the work of established artists throughout the month of June. Specific locations are noted in the program and on the digital ballot. Everyone is invited to get involved and vote for the artwork they like the most.

- The **“People’s Choice Award”** ballot can be accessed from any digital device, computer, tablet or mobile via the QR Code printed in the **WEEKLY** program, on the T-shirts, the [web site](#) and [Facebook page](#) for the Junebug Artfest. Voting will begin with the opening of the Artfest and close at midnight, Friday, June 17.
- **“Best in Show”** will be awarded by two museum curators, 8pm on the Main Stage, Main & New Streets, Saturday, June 18
